Message from the Headteacher

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back to school – I hope you all had an enjoyable half term break and are ready for a busy half term ahead!

Today, we have been thinking about Remembrance Day and the importance of remembering all of those who have been involved in war. Thank you for the donations to the Royal British Legion.

Next week is Anti-Bullying Week. As part of this, I shall be talking to children in the school assembly about the NSPCC's 'Speak Out. Stay Safe.' programme, which is designed for children aged 5-11 and aims to help them understand abuse in all its forms and to recognise the signs of abuse. Children are taught to speak out if they are worried, either to a safe adult or to Childline. If you would like to know more about the 'Speak out. 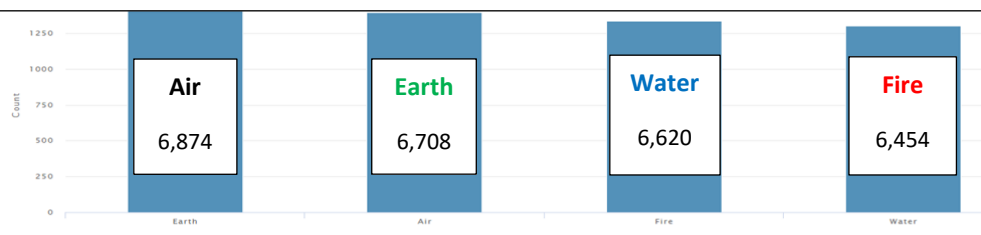
